EGG HARBOR, WI (WTAQ) - A 63-year-old year De Pere man spent nearly 10 hours swimming across the bay to bring awareness for children with disabilities.

Don McDonald left the shores of Marinette around 7:30 a.m. Saturday and arrived in Egg Harbor around a little after 5 p.m.

McDonald swam 15-miles across the bay battling strong winds and a rough current while friends followed in a boat.

McDonald says while in the water he was inspired by the challenges that children with disabilities face every day helped push him finish line.

McDonald hopes that his journey will also lift their spirits.

McDonald was swimming to benefit a hypnotherapy and therapeutic horseback riding program Exceptional Equestrians, for children with disabilities.

The program is looking to expand and already helps between 75 and 100 families in northeast Wisconsin every year
